The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held its regular meeting on Wednesday, February 1, 2012, at 5:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Bronte I. S. D. at 210 S. Jefferson, Bronte, Texas. President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.

The financial report and list of expenditures were considered. Martin Lee moved that these be approved as presented. David Bedford seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Election of officers was considered. Lee Wommack moved that the following officers be elected: President—Gerald Sandusky; Vice-President—Alan Richey; Secretary—David Bedford; Treasurer—Martha Ratliff. David Bedford seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tammy Thorn reported that she is working on a business prospect lead received from the governor's office. This is the first prospect lead that Bronte has met all requirements for since the governor's office initiated this program.
