Mrs. Williams departed the meeting.



The Texas Department of Public Safety will no longer be issuing vehicle inspection stickers but rather a printed receipt that will be carried by the customer to the county court house when registering the vehicle. Due to this, the PROVIDER will need to buy a printer, ink and paper that will be compatible to the state equipment that is now being used for the inspections. They also recommend a back up printer or warranty that will provide next day replacement.

Due to the added expense we have requested a grant from the Economic Development Board for no more than \$800.00 to purchase the needed equipment so we may continue to provide this service to our customers in Bronte and the surrounding counties.

Larry's Automotive, LLC will provide the Bronte EDC with copies of all receipts from the purchase of the printer, ink, and paper.




