


The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held a public hearing on Wednesday, June 15, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Room of Bronte City Hall at 114 South Washington, Bronte, Texas. The purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comments concerning the Corporation use of Economic Development funds for Bronte Restoration Foundation projects (Bronte Park Restoration). President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.

Board members present included: President Sandusky, Quinda Duncan, Paul Knight, Martha Ratliff, and Lee Wommack. Martin Lee was absent. Clerk Fran Sonnenberg and Bronte Park Restoration representatives Marlayna Schoenfield, Ashley Braswell and Jodie Arrott were also present. No visitors were present for public comment.


The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held a special meeting beginning at 5:06 p.m. following the public hearing. President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.

The board reviewed the bills submitted from Rodrigo Cecilio for the fence building and Texas Courts & Windscreens for the repair and resurfacing work on one tennis court and one basketball court at the park. Lee Wommack moved that the board approve payment of \$9,655 to Texas Courts & Windscreens for their work and approve payment of \$7,400 to Rodrigo Cecilio for the fence building. Martha Ratliff seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Since Mr. Cecilio's statement was higher than his bid, the Restoration committee will arrange a meeting with him and an EDC representative to discuss the difference. The EDC board agreed to hold another public hearing to consider an additional payment to Mr. Cecilio if such payment is due him.

Lee Wommack moved that the meeting adjourn. Quinda Duncan seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
